OUR PROMISE

NDFS is committed to respecting your privacy and ensuring the personal information you have entrusted to us is held securely. We will process personal information in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation and the Privacy & Electronic Communications Regulations 2003.

HOW WE COLLECT PERSONAL INFORMATION

We collect personal information in the following ways:

Directly from you if you:

- Make a donation
- Visit our website. Please see our Cookies section for more information;
- Become an NDFS ambassador
- Sign up on our website to receive updates for one or more of our projects;
- Contact us with an enquiry;
- Working in partnership with NDFS

From other sources:

- We may use the Royal Mail's postcode finder or the electoral roll to check the accuracy of the address we hold.

The personal information we collect:

- Personal identifiers such as your title, name and organisation
- Contact details including postal address, post code, email and telephone number

- Financial information such as your bank details
- Whether you are a UK based
- The event location where you signed up to our newsletter

Sensitive personal data

The Data Protection Act recognises some information as 'sensitive personal data'. This includes, but is not limited to, information which reveals your religious beliefs, health issues, race or ethnic origin.

NDFSN will always treat any sensitive personal data we process with great care and process the information in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation.

WHY WE COLLECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

- To process any donations.
- When you visit our website, we may gather information about which pages you visit to help us improve and provide you with the best service.
- To determine and improve the effectiveness of our website and marketing campaigns.
- To organise and coordinate NDFSN events
- To keep you informed about our work.
- To manage and coordinate our ambassadors
- For compliance with employment law and other statutory requirements.

CREDIT AND DEBIT CARD PAYMENT INFORMATION

When you make a donation to us online online, your details will be held securely by a third party. We will only see details of the sum which you have donated.

WHO WE SHARE YOUR INFORMATION WITH

NDFSN never sells information to other charities or organisations nor does it share information with organisations .

NDFSN may use the Mailchimp or WIX email service to send you emails. Both Wix and Mailchimp are also bound by the General Data Protection Regulation. Please see their [privacy policy](#) for further information.

NDFSN may be under duty to disclose your personal information where required in order to comply with any legal obligation.

HOW LONG WE KEEP YOUR DATA

NDFSN will only keep your personal information for as long as it is required or in accordance with statutory requirements. Where the information is no longer required, we will ensure that it is disposed of in a secure manner.

If you have indicated that you do not wish to hear from us in the future, we will keep the minimum information necessary to ensure we fulfil our legal obligations.

YOUR INFORMATION RIGHTS AND CHOICES

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) gives you the right:

- To choose whether or not to receive marketing communication from us by email, text or telephone.
- To request in writing and securely obtain copies of the personal information NDFSN holds about you. Please see the [Information Commissioner's website](#) for regulations and exemptions.
- To correct or update your personal information processed by NDFSN.
- To request NDFSN to stop using your personal information for marketing purposes or for any other purpose where there is no legal requirement for continued processing.

The Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR) gives you the right:
